Please Take Recyclables From Home to Public Drop-off Center



Examples: Water, sports drink, mouthwash, and catsup bottles. Peanut butter, pickle, jelly, and jam jars. *Caps are OK



Examples: Milk, juice, laundry detergent, and shampoo bottles. Rulers, hula-hoops, cereal box liners. Yogurt and margarine tubs. Grocery, trash, and retail bags.



Examples: Some juice bottles, PVC pipes, cling film, clear PVC food and non-food packaging.

Examples: Dry cleaning, bread, produce, and frozen food bags, squeezable bottles (e.g. honey, mustard), drinking straws.



Examples: Margarine tubs, yogurt containers, medicine bottles, caps, DVD cases (separate the DVD from the case, we'll take both). **NO TYVEK**



Examples: CD cases (separate the CD from the case, we'll take both), aspirin bottles. **CLEAN**: cups, plates and cutlery. **NO STYROFOAM**



Examples: Three- and five-gallon reusable water bottles, baby bottles, lab pipette boxes, iced tea or juice bottles. Electronic casing.
