### **RECYCLE CD CASES**

Cases are made from plastic #6 polystyrene and can be recycled at the MSU recycling drop-off site located on Green Way, off Farm Lane, open 24/7.

### **NOTES**

-Check the internet for many creative ways to reuse CDs/DVDs, disks, cases and even tape from VHS.

-CDs contain three main components: plastic, metals and ink. Discs are made mostly from polycarbonate and a small amount of lacquer used as a protective coating. Aluminum is the primary metal, but traces amount of gold, silver and nickel are present.
