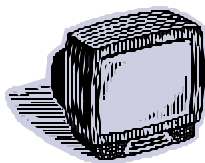
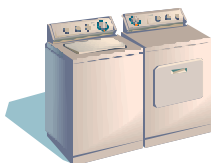

Items Accepted:

Electronics: Computers (all types), computer accessories (keyboards, scanners, printers, etc.), televisions (all sizes), stereos/speakers, microwaves, copy machines, CD/DVD players, VCR's, telephones (land lines and cell phones), coffee makers, vacuum cleaners, toasters and other household items with a cord

Household batteries

Books: All types, including hard and soft cover, telephone books, etc.

CD's and DVD's

Clothing: Must be in wearable condition. No scrap textiles will be accepted.

Shoes: Place shoes in pairs

Household Goods (see back side for list of accepted items)

Unwanted medicine: Leave in original containers and cross out personal information

Appliances/Scrap metal

Bicycles

Dehumidifiers

Room air conditioners

#1-#7 plastics: Includes garden plastic pots and trays (shake off dirt and debris)

Glass jars, bottles and containers (including green glass)

Compact Fluorescent Lightbulbs (CFL's)

Mercury thermostats: Leave intact

Mercury thermometers: Place in ziplock bag

Used household fats, cooking oil, and grease

Polystyrene foam (Styrofoam) - No packing peanuts

Fabrics/Yarn: Fabrics in usable condition only - 1/4 yard or larger. Full skeins of yarn only.

Eyeglasses

Corks: Traditional only, no plastic corks
